Three-dimensional work may be submitted with prior approval from the show coordinator. There will be an entry fee of \$25 for submission of one or two works. Cash prizes will be awarded.

Drop-off dates: June 22- June 29, between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm.

Announcement of juror selection: Saturday, July 2

Artist reception: Sunday, July 10, 3-5 pm.

Pick up of exhibited work: August 4, 5 and 6, 9 am to 5 pm.
